


Finding God for Grades 1-5

Saint Isidore the Farmer

Isidore lived in Madrid, Spain. He and his wife, Blessed Maria de la Cabeza, lived on a rich man's farm. Isidore took care of the man's land with love. While Isidore worked on the farm, he prayed to God. Angels often helped him with his chores.

Isidore suffered hard times, but he was always loving and caring. He was devoted to God and his work. Isidore cared for the earth, plants, and animals. He understood that it is important to care for all of creation. Although Isidore and his wife were poor, they shared what they had with others. They often gave food to those who were hungry.

Saint Isidore is the patron saint of farmers and laborers. We celebrate his feast day on May 15.


ACTIVITY: Love and Kindness

Read and listen to Genesis 1:26–27.

God the Father creates everything in our world, including people. He makes us like himself. Of all the wonderful and amazing creations in our world, we are closest to and the most like God. He loves and cares for us. God gave us the important job of taking care of his creation, just as he takes care of us. We can praise and thank God by treating all living things with love and respect. When we show love for God's creation, we are showing love for God.


